

## **Acceptable Use Policy**

The user may not access or use GCloud (“the service”) for any unlawful or unauthorized purposes. Users agree to comply with all local laws regarding privacy and the protection of personal data, online conduct and the legality of content.

The user may not access or use, or attempt to access or use, the service to take any action that could harm any person or entity, interfere with the operation of the service, or use the service in a manner that violates any laws.

For example, you may not:

- Falsely state or otherwise misrepresent your credentials and affiliation;
- Engage in unauthorized automated means to compile information;
- Obtain or attempt to gain unauthorized access to other computer systems, information or any services available on or through the service;
- Use any device or software to interfere or attempt to interfere with the proper working of the service or attempt to probe, scan, test the vulnerability of, or breach the security of any system, device or network;
- The use or distribution of tools designed for compromising security (e.g., password guessing programs, cracking tools or network probing tools) is strictly prohibited;
- Take any action that imposes disproportionately large load on network or infrastructure;
- Upload or otherwise transmit software or material that contains a virus or is otherwise harmful to the computers, devices or external systems and its users.

In case of violations of system or network security and other above mentioned conduct by the user we may suspend or terminate access to the service and remove content without notice. In circumstances of violating security rules we may cooperate with law enforcement authorities.
